<u>21.229 PLANNING APPLICATION DC/21/06953</u> – Proposed by I Richardson, seconded by M Sealby it was agreed to object to this application on the following grounds:

- The area should remain as agricultural land rather than have a large agricultural building erected.
- The size of the building is at odds with the amount of machinery needed for the size of the land.
- There are Grade II listed buildings in the area, and these will be impacted by the barn. The application says the buildings will not be visually impacted by the barn, but we believe they will be.
- The proposed barn is not in keeping with the area, it is far too modern looking. It is also 2.5 times the size of Angel Hill Farm which will be overshadowed.
- There is no recent environmental assessment and no surveys regarding great crested newts.
- There is no offset biodiversity report provided for the construction of the building. The diagram provided does not meet the biodiversity criteria.
- We support the other objections submitted.
